The Street will close to vehicle traffic from 10:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. All vendors must have your own 10x10 tent (preferably white, but we will make exceptions for this special weekend market) and be responsible for set up and break down. Set up is permitted only between 10:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m., and break down is permitted only between 3:30 p.m. and 4:30 p.m., weather permitting. There will be live music by Phinaes Gage, a communal seating area on the Village Green to enjoy all the great food & drink, our 3rd annual amateur apple pie baking contest, and wonderful shopping from our artisan vendors. Parking & Restrooms

NOTE: PARK STREET IS NOW A ONE-WAY STREET, HEADING NORTHBOUND WITH PARKING SPOTS.

Vendors are expected to unload by driving UP PARK STREET FROM POND STREET, and then vendors must move your vehicles to off-street parking, allowing for patrons to use the spots along Main Street. The same is expected for reloading at the end of the day, which will be done by driving UP Park Street from Pond Street. Public restrooms are located at Stowe Area Association and on the Depot Street side of the Stowe Mercantile shops.

Firearms & Drugs, Alcohol Sales

Sales of Firearms and Drugs (or Drug Paraphernalia) will not be permitted in any instance. Alcohol sales will be permitted on a case-by-case basis, and the vendor(s) is/are responsible for all local and state permits.

Vendors

All Art on Park markets are an opportunity for local Craftsman, Artists and Artisans to showcase your hard work. We encourage each vendor to maintain high quality and safety standards. Each vendor must complete an application and return it to Shari Vermeulen at shari@stovevibrancy.com or Stowe Vibrancy, P.O. Box 482, Stowe, VT 05672.

Products

Each vendor must sell products produced, created, designed or processed yourself. Buy/sell items, items made from kits, and commercially manufactured products are not allowed.

Sales Tax

Each Vendor is responsible for sales tax and state and federal business licenses.

Space Information- Set up and Break down

Stowe Foliage Art on Park will open to the public at 11:30 a.m. and will continue until 3:30 p.m. Vendors may begin setting up at 10:00 a.m., when Park Street closes, not before. Set-up must be complete by 11:30 a.m. Vendors who have not arrived and checked in by 10:30 a.m. could forfeit your space. (Exceptions may be allowed on a case-by-case basis with proper notification, call Shari @ 802.585.5131). Space assignments will be determined by the Market Manager and will be provided to the vendors by email prior to the market date. Vendors are responsible for breaking down your stalls and picking up after yourselves. Vendors are responsible for providing tables, chairs, a 10x10 canopy/tent (preferably in white,



but other colors will be accepted for this special weekend market), etc. Vendors are responsible for your property and any loss, damages or theft to your property. All tables, chairs, tents, etc. must be secured by weights and positioned out of the way of the event foot traffic throughout the course of the Market. Refunds will NOT be given, in any instance, due to weather conditions. This event has a rain date of Sunday, September 23, 11:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and the Market Manager will make the decision should it be necessary. (At this time electricity is only available to a select few vendors and it MUST be pre-arranged by contacting Shari Vermeulen at shari@stovevibrancy.com).

Staffing

Vendor stalls must be staffed at all times by the artist, business owner or an employee of the business.

Disputes

All Art on Park markets are a community effort. If disputes cannot be resolved, the Market Manager may be called in to mediate. In this case, the Market Manager's decision will be final. Grievances may be submitted in writing to the Market Manager at shari@stovevibrancy.com.

Violations

All Art on Park markets were created to enhance the Stowe Community and misconduct will not be permitted. Discrimination, illegal behavior or failure to abide by these Guidelines will not be tolerated. A verbal warning will be issued first, followed by expulsion from the Market. In the case of expulsion, fees will not be refunded. Stowe Vibrancy, Inc. reserves the right to amend these Guidelines as it sees fit to maintain the safety and success of All Art on Park markets, the community and guests of the Market.

Certification

I have reviewed the guidelines, agree to have a staffed attendant for the entire event, and to take responsibility for my work. I will hold Stowe Vibrancy, Inc. its owners, directors and employees harmless from any loss or damages whatsoever.
